1. Motivation. The motivational statement must describe your motivation for applying for the Inflammation Network steering committee, including a description of (see scheme for further details):
 - a. Your academic ambitions as a steering committee member e.g. specific ideas for new network activities or ability to contribute to existing activities (e.g., Annual Inflammation Network Day)
 - b. Activities and experiences relevant to the committee work
 - c. Which infection & inflammation research area and methodology you are working with
